3. Raksha is not responsible for confirming the quality or valuation of any Artwork in any Raksha art catalog or otherwise for sale during the Art Show.
4. The price indicated in any Raksha art catalog is the final listing price. Any price negotiations at the time of sale are at the artist's sole discretion and not guaranteed or facilitated by Raksha or any artist.
5. Raksha is not in physical possession of any Artwork to be sold in this virtual event. As such, Raksha is not involved in and thus takes no responsibility for any Artwork damage upon sale or shipment.
6. Returns, refunds and exchanging policies are at the sole discretion of each individual artist. All issues regarding exchanges, returns or refunds must be handled directly between the buyer and the artist.
7. All sales and transactions, including shipping, refunds and returns, as applicable, are the sole responsibility of the buyer and artist. Raksha is not liable for any monetary exchanges, transaction errors or losses in payment or during the shipping process.
